WORK EXPERIENCE OPPORTUNITY ABROAD WITH THE ERASMUS+ STUDENT MOBILITY

The College offers students the opportunity to gain valuable work experience abroad, fully funded by the European Commission. This opportunity is open to all further education students participating on a full-time Level 5 course and who will be over the age of 18 at the date of travel. Twenty students will be selected and will complete 10 days work experience in their vocational area.



AWARDS AND PROGRESSION PATHWAYS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

All our courses lead to a QQI award, which is an internationally recognised qualification. Successful completion of a Major QQI Award at Level 5 or Level 6 allows you to apply through the CAO system for entry into participating courses in the Higher Education Links Scheme (HELS). HELS reserves places on specified courses for holders of full QQI certificates.



FEES

There are no tuition fees for courses. However, there are registration fees and other charges. Full details of fees per course are available from the College.

GRANTS

Students on full-time Post Leaving Certificate courses may apply for the SUSI grant. Students are recommended to apply as early as possible on www.susi.ie.



APPLYING

The College holds an Open Day each year, generally early in the New Year. Application for all courses is online on the www. greenhillscollege.ie website. Interviews are held at various times during the year, following which places are allocated. Students are requested to pay a non-refundable deposit to secure their place, once they have been offered it. Where courses are full, students may be placed on a waiting list and allocated places as they become available.

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORTS

The College applies for funding from the Higher Education Authority for students who need extra supports and resources. This applies to students in Post Leaving Certificate courses. Students who need such supports should fill in the relevant form and return it to the College as soon as possible after they have accepted the offer of a place. Students will be requested to submit copies of Educational and other assessments.

V.T.O.S.

A number of courses are available to V.T.O.S. applicants. These courses have no fees, provide stationery and books free of charge, and offer a small additional payment to eligible students. Full details are available from the College.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The College welcomes international students. Full details of fees and other requirements are available from the College. Students should note that all classes are conducted in the English language and proficiency in both written and spoken English is essential. Applicants may be required to do an English language test.


